When the Print/Save button is clicked in TrueChem, an addslip containing the calculated adds from the current tank is normally created. *(note that your term for "addslip" may be something different, for example "test report")* 

But sometimes it's desirable to perform your test and postpone creating the addslip so that you can later choose which adds (across all your tanks) are to be placed on a *"flexible"* addslip. To do this for all tanks, go to System Setup > Addslip tab, and choose "Flexible Addslip" for the addslip Type. Or you can turn on this capability for just certain tanks by going to the Tank Setup > Addslip tab.

If Flexible Addslips are being used for a tank, then tests performed from that tank will not generate an addslip when the Print/Save button is clicked. Instead, the user would go to the Addslip Log and select which adds will go on a flexible addslip. See Figure 1.

The top section of the Addslip Log shows addslips as usual. The lower section shows the adds that are available to be placed on a flexible addslip. In this section you can highlight several adds (i.e. rows) and click the Create Flexible Addslip button to place them on a new, flexible addslip. That addslip will then appear in the upper section of the Addslip Log. You can also sign off an add, but such adds will never appear on an addslip because only adds that have *not* been signed off are displayed in the lower section.
